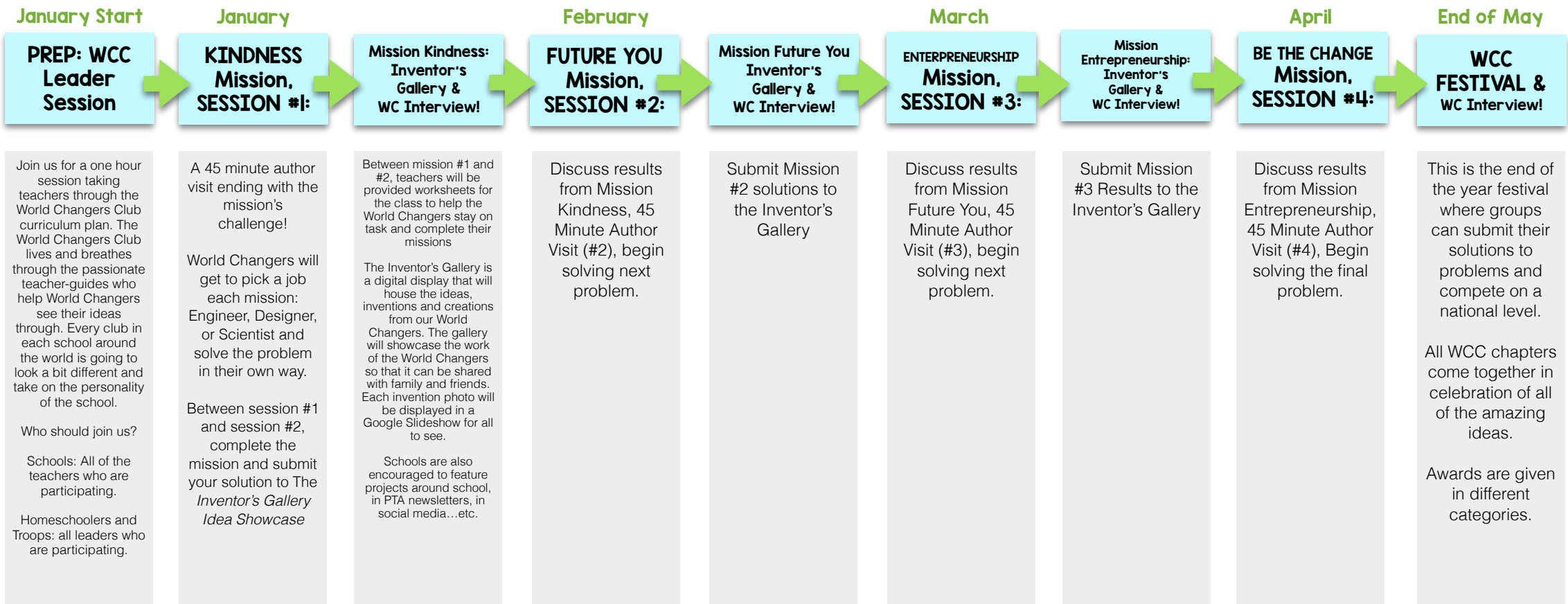

- Offer supporting books to your World Changers through the provided *custom book list*.

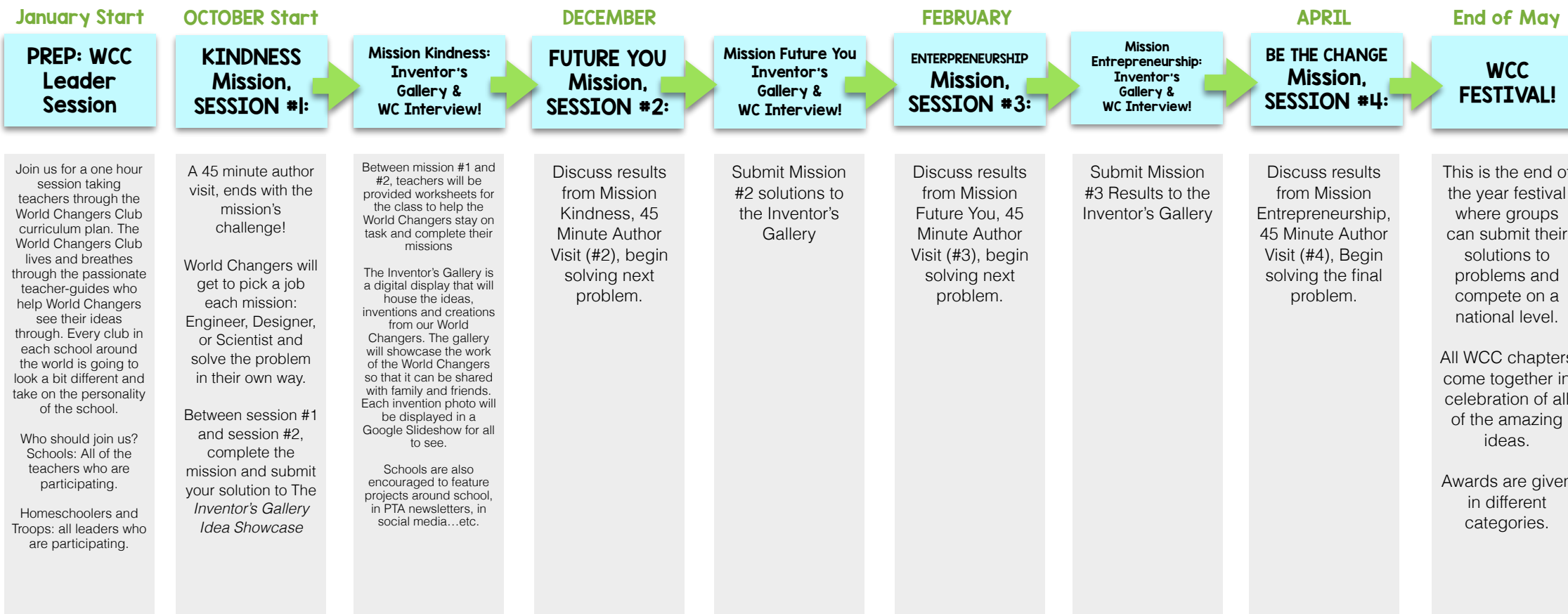

Curriculum Overview & Program Philosophy

Why are there four sessions?

The four sessions are written as a continuation of one another.

Changing the world doesn't happen in a single session: it takes time, focus, and dedication.

When can we start?

You may join the World Changers Club at ANY point in the year! It's always the right time to start changing the world.

Why is the Inventor's Gallery so important?

Through the sharing of goals, perspectives, and unique solutions: it lets someone know that they have value.

The WCC is all about thinking, doing, and solving using out magic powers of creativity, ingenuity, and scientific research.

What are the four unit topics?

Session #1: KINDNESS:

We believe that changing the world starts with Kindness. This unit helps World Changers to shift their perspective, see opportunities, and put kindness into worldly action through creative problem solving.

Session #2: FUTURE YOU:

We understand that is it important to be kind to ourselves, that we have the power to make an impact, and to understand what makes us uniquely sparkle.

This unit is all about the discovery of our authentic selves.

Session #3: ENTREPRENEURSHIP
